

## Denver Union Station Construction Notification

Construction activities will begin February 22, 2010 for the Denver Union Station Redevelopment Project and will continue for the next 4 years.



## First Signs of Construction -

 Traffic control will be set up on Wewatta – traffic will be one lane in each direction on the southbound side for a few weeks and then move to one lane in each direction on the northbound side.

## Early activities will include:

- Removal of concrete /clearing on 17<sup>th</sup> Street
- Set up pedestrian traffic control
- Excavation for bus facility
  - o Ground water will be pumped out
  - Shoring walls at Wewatta and the LRT will begin
  - Excavated dirt will be stock piled or removed
    - Very large piles 20' to 30' in height
    - Soil will have tackifier on it so it won't erode with wind or water
      - DirtGlue is environmentally friendly
- Relocation of utilities
- Begin work on the relocation of Amtrak to temporary location
  - Building improvements/tenant finishes for new facility
  - Preparation for the track and temporary platform

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
