

## Denver Union Station Construction Update 3-4-10

## **Traffic and Pedestrian Configuration -**



- Traffic will be redirected on Wewatta St. between 16<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> St. to one lane in each direction beginning **March 5, 2010**. RTD bus stops will be relocated to accommodate the changed traffic pattern. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There will be signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
- Pedestrians going from the Millennium Bridge to Wewatta along 16<sup>th</sup> St. will be directed to the south side starting March 12<sup>th</sup>; the sidewalk on the north side will be closed.

## Other activities over the next 2 weeks will include:

- Barrier will be placed along Wewatta St. to protect the traveling public
- Removal of light poles on the west side of Wewatta St.
- Relocate construction fencing to curb line along 16<sup>th</sup> St. from the Millennium Bridge through Wewatta St.
- Concrete removal on the west side of Wewatta St.
- Pumping of ground water and bus facility excavation will begin mid-March
- Shoring wall at the LRT will continue
- Relocation of Wewatta St. utilities
