

## Denver Union Station Construction Update 4-5-10

## Construction activities over the next 2 weeks will include:

- Dirt excavation for the underground bus facility
  - There will be truck activity associated with this work
- Wall construction for the light rail tracks
- Various utility work relocations and installations
- Pumping of ground water
- Removal of non-essential track
- Installation of communication fiber on Speer Blvd. between Wewatta St. and Blake St. may require lane restrictions and will begin the first week in April and continue for about a month
- Construction activities will be on on-going on both sides of Wewatta St. between 20<sup>th</sup> St and 16<sup>th</sup> St.

## **Traffic and Pedestrian Configuration -**



- Traffic on Wewatta St. between 16<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> St. is in a one lane in each direction configuration on the northbound side. RTD bus stops have relocated to north end closer to 19<sup>th</sup> St. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There is signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
- Access for pedestrians traveling on 16<sup>th</sup> St. between the Millennium Bridge and Wewatta St. is on the south sidewalk. There is a fence in place to protect pedestrians. Pedestrians in this area need to be alert to light rail trains traffic.
