

Denver Union Station Construction Update 5-24-10

Construction activities over the next 2 weeks will include:

- Excavation for the underground bus facility using the conveyor system
- Utility installation
- Concrete retaining walls for the light rail tracks
- Set-up of "lay down yard" where materials will be stored for construction of bus facility structure
- Pumping of ground water
- Installation of communication fiber on Wewatta St. between 14th St./South Platte River and 16th St.



Temporary Traffic and Pedestrian Changes:

- Lane and sidewalk restrictions on Wewatta St. between 14th St./South Platte River and 15th St. beginning May 24th for approximately 1 week for communication fiber installation. Traffic and pedestrians travel patterns will be changing in this area as work moves, so look for directional signage.
- Lane and sidewalk restrictions on Wewatta St. between 15th St and 16th St. beginning June 1st for approximately 1 week for communication fiber installation. Traffic and pedestrians travel patterns will be changing in this area as work moves, so look for directional signage.

On-Going Traffic and Pedestrian Configuration:

- Traffic on Wewatta St. between 16th St. and 19th St. is one lane in each direction on the northbound side. RTD bus stops have relocated to the north end closer to 19th St. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There is signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
- Access for pedestrians traveling on 16th St. between the Millennium Bridge and Wewatta St. is on the south sidewalk. There is a fence in place to protect pedestrians.
 Pedestrians in this area need to be alert to light rail train traffic.
