



# Denver Union Station Construction Update 5-24-10

## Construction activities over the next 2 weeks will include:

- Excavation for the underground bus facility using the conveyor system
- Utility installation
- Concrete retaining walls for the light rail tracks
- Set-up of "lay down yard" where materials will be stored for construction of bus facility structure
- Pumping of ground water
- Installation of communication fiber on Wewatta St. between 14<sup>th</sup> St./South Platte River and 16<sup>th</sup> St.



## Temporary Traffic and Pedestrian Changes:

- Lane and sidewalk restrictions on Wewatta St. between 14<sup>th</sup> St./South Platte River and 15<sup>th</sup> St. beginning May 24<sup>th</sup> for approximately 1 week for communication fiber installation. Traffic and pedestrians travel patterns will be changing in this area as work moves, so look for directional signage.
- Lane and sidewalk restrictions on Wewatta St. between 15<sup>th</sup> St and 16<sup>th</sup> St. beginning June 1<sup>st</sup> for approximately 1 week for communication fiber installation. Traffic and pedestrians travel patterns will be changing in this area as work moves, so look for directional signage.

## On-Going Traffic and Pedestrian Configuration:

- Traffic on Wewatta St. between 16<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> St. is one lane in each direction on the northbound side. RTD bus stops have relocated to the north end closer to 19<sup>th</sup> St. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There is signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
- Access for pedestrians traveling on 16<sup>th</sup> St. between the Millennium Bridge and Wewatta St. is on the south sidewalk. There is a fence in place to protect pedestrians. Pedestrians in this area need to be alert to light rail train traffic.
