Denver CO—The Denver Union Station Project Authority (DUSPA), Regional Transportation District (RTD) and Union Station Neighborhood Company (USNC) will be conducting free walking tours of the Denver Union Station redevelopment site this summer. The tours will be held at 4:30 p.m. on the third Thursday of the month beginning June 17 and continuing through September on July 15, August 18 and September 16. The one-hour tour will depart from the main entrance of the historic station on Wynkoop Street.

The walking tour will include information on the storied history of Union Station from the late 1800s to the present day. You will learn about the early station buildings and famous travelers who visited Denver by train, hear about the new Union Station Neighborhood and its transformation of downtown, get an update on the expansion of RTD's transit services coming to the area and witness construction of the largest transportation redevelopment project in North America first hand.
