



Denver Union Station Construction Update 9-27-10

Construction activities over the next weeks will include:

At the Temporary Amtrak Station

- Completing the remodeling of the building at corner of 21st and Wewatta St. including improvements to the parking area
- Commuter rail/temporary Amtrak platform
 - Grading
 - Walls
 - Installation of ductbank
 - Canopy foundations
 - Delivery of rail

At the Underground Bus Facility

- Continued erection of walls – forming and pouring concrete
- Form and pour columns

At the LRT

- Canopy foundations
- Installation of ductbank
- Erect canopy frames
- Delivery of rail

Other Construction Activities in the area:

Construction activities along Wewatta St. between Speer and 16th are being done by Concrete Works for the Central Platte Valley Metropolitan District. The project is a joint project between the District and 1400 Wynkoop in cooperation with the City and County of Denver. The work will improve the east half of Wewatta Street from Speer to 15th Street, complete the five lanes from 16th to 15th Streets, and provide upgraded signalization at the intersection of 15th and Wewatta Streets. Xcel and other utility companies will be working around 15th and Delgany St. Both of these projects will require lane restrictions in the area.



On-Going and New Traffic and Pedestrian Configurations:

- Traffic on Wewatta St. between 16th St. and 19th St. is one lane in each direction on the northbound side. RTD bus stops have relocated to the north end closer to 19th St. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There is signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
