



## Denver Union Station Construction Update January 2011

### Construction activities over the next weeks will include:

*At the Temporary Amtrak Station - Amtrak will move all operations to the new temporary facility at 21<sup>st</sup> St. and Wewatta St. on February 1, 2011*

- Completing platforms
- Installation track

*At the Underground Bus Facility*

- Pour top deck in a similar manner to the base slab in 160 cubic yard sections
- Continue work in mechanical room
- Prepare for enclosure of structure and work to begin inside

*At the LRT*

- Installation of track
- Platform finish work
- Installing PTFE fabric on canopy structural steel



### On-Going and New Traffic and Pedestrian Configurations:

- Traffic on Wewatta St. between 16<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> St. is one lane in each direction on the northbound side. RTD bus stops have relocated to the north end closer to 19<sup>th</sup> St. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There is signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
- The construction fence along 16<sup>th</sup> St between the Millennium Bridge and Wewatta St. has been moved to be directly adjacent to the LRT tracks. Pedestrians must use the sidewalk along the south side of 16<sup>th</sup> St. and yield to LRT trains when crossing at the east end of the Millennium Bridge.
  - For everyone's safety, pedestrians should not walk along the LRT tracks and should use the sidewalk adjacent to the building on 16<sup>th</sup> St and use the designated crosswalk.
- There will be utility work on Wynkoop St. from 15<sup>th</sup> St. to 19<sup>th</sup> St. beginning in mid-January 2011 and continuing for a few months. The work is being done by different utility organizations and contractors. There will be lane and parking restrictions associated with this work.
