# **DENVER UNION STATION (DUS) PROJECT UPDATE**

#### **FEBRUARY 2011**

The Denver Union Station Project continues to make significant progress. We wanted you to be aware of the major construction-related activities you will see during 2011.

## **CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES**

- Feb. 4: Opening of temporary Amtrak Station at 1800 21st St.
- Feb. 4: Closure of the pedestrian tunnel from the historic station to the current light rail platform and Mall Shuttle stop.
- Feb. 9: Closure of the Bus/HOV lane behind DUS and re-routing of peak hour Regional and Express buses to Market Street Station.
- Spring 2011: Construction of Chestnut Place.
- Summer 2011: Opening of the new Light Rail Station and the extension of the 16th Street Mall Shuttle to the station.
- Summer 2011: Closure of Wewatta Street behind DUS and opening of Chestnut Place.
- **Summer 2011:** Construction will begin on the next phase of the underground bus facility from Wewatta St. to the west side of the DUS building.
- Ongoing: Continued utility relocation.
- Ongoing: Work on the interior of the current phase of the underground bus facility.

## **AMTRAK MOVING TO TEMPORARY STATION FEBRUARY 4**

Beginning Feb. 4, Amtrak will temporarily relocate from the historic Denver Union Station to 1800 21<sup>st</sup> St., at the intersection of 21<sup>st</sup> St. and Wewatta St., west of Coors Field in Downtown Denver's Prospect Neighborhood. Amtrak with return to DUS in spring 2014.

#### PEDESTRIAN TUNNEL CLOSING AT DUS

Another change coming on Feb. 4 is the permanent closure of the pedestrian tunnel. Transit customers can use either the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Mall Shuttle or the 16<sup>th</sup> St. sidewalk to get to and from the light rail platform.

## **BUS/HOV LANE OPERATIONS CHANGES**

On Feb. 9, the Bus/HOV lane behind DUS will close to accommodate construction. Buses that use the Bus/HOV lane will no longer pick-up and drop-off transit customers behind DUS.

All passengers who board/de-board at DUS Gates B, C and D now will do so at Market Street Station.

Inbound buses will go from 19<sup>th</sup> St. to Blake St.; Blake St. to 16<sup>th</sup> St.; and enter into Market Street Station.

Outbound buses will pick up passengers inside Market Street Station; follow 16<sup>th</sup> St. to Wazee St.; Wazee St. to 19<sup>th</sup> St.; and head to the Bus/HOV lane.
