



# Denver Union Station Construction Update Summer 2011

## **At the Underground Bus Facility**

### *Wewatta St. to West side of DUS Building*

- Dewatering for 2<sup>nd</sup> half between Wewatta St and DUS Building
- Excavation and removals to stockpile
- Shoring walls adjacent to historic building
- Demolition of old walls/tunnels/pavement

### *LRT Station to Wewatta*

- Work in the interior of the structure including installation of electrical/mechanical rough-ins
- Chestnut pavilion structure, including escalator, stairs and elevator access into bus facility
- Train bridge caissons

## **At the LRT**

- Complete east platform
- Tie-in LRT tracks and OCS to existing lines
- Plaza area including sidewalks and pedestrian areas
- LRT and 16<sup>th</sup> St Mall Shuttle service will move to the new permanent location at the western edge of the project in late summer
- Demo all existing LRT facilities



## **On-Going and New Traffic and Pedestrian Configurations:**

- Until August 14, 2011, traffic on Wewatta St. between 16<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> St. is one lane in each direction on the northbound side. RTD bus stops have relocated to the north end closer to 19<sup>th</sup> St. There is signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
- Starting August 15, 2011, Wewatta St. between 16<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> will be closed for construction. Motorists will be directed to use Chestnut Place from 19<sup>th</sup> St to 16<sup>th</sup> St. Traffic will remain in this configuration until 2014.
- Work to install a storm sewer at the intersection of 15<sup>th</sup> and Delgany St and then moving along Delgany St between 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> will begin June 20 and be ongoing for the remainder of the summer. There will be parking/sidewalk restrictions and lane restrictions and closures associated with this work.
- There will be pavement repair work on Wynkoop St between 18<sup>th</sup> St. and 19<sup>th</sup> St. and on 19<sup>th</sup> at the intersection with Wynkoop St. during July. This work will require short-term lane restrictions/closures.
