DENVER UNION STATION PROJECT UPDATE

December 2011

The Denver Union Station Project continues to make significant progress. We wanted you to be aware of the major construction-related activities you will see during winter 2011/2012.



LIGHT BLUE AREA

Reconstruction of 16th St. between Wewatta St. and Wynkoop St.

- Construction will begin in mid-December and continue for several months
- 16th Street FreeMall Ride service will be maintained
- Pedestrian access will be on the south side of 16th St.

GREEN AREA

Construction area for a retaining wall adjacent to the Ice House/Rodizio Grill

- Construction will begin late December and last 4-6 weeks
- · Access will be maintained to the Ice House garage

RED AREA

- Parking areas will close on Jan. 3, 2012
- Crews will be removing asphalt and building plaza areas
- Construction will continue until 2014

BLUE AREA

- The circle drive and sidewalk in front of DUS will close on Jan. 3, 2012
- The drive will be removed and the sidewalk will be rebuilt along Wynkoop St.
- Decorative bricks will be removed and replaced
- Access to the historic building will be maintained

Please note that other construction may be occurring in the area simultaneously.



INFORMATION ABOUT THE TEMPORARY AMTRAK STATION

Amtrak has temporarily relocated from the historic Denver Union Station to 1800 21st St., at the intersection of 21st St. and Wewatta St., west of Coors Field in Downtown Denver's Prospect Neighborhood. Amtrak will return to DUS in spring 2014.



TRAVELING FROM DUS TO THE TEMPORARY AMTRAK STATION (1800 21st ST., DENVER 80202)

DRIVING FROM DUS Travel southwest of Wynkoop St. toward 15th St. Turn right on 15th St. Take first right on Wewatta St. Continue to 16th St. Turn left on 16th St. Take first right onto Chestnut Pl. Follow Chestnut Pl. to 19th St. Turn right on Chestnut Pl. to 19th St. Turn right on 19th to Wewatta St. Turn left on Wewatta St. Continue on Wewatta St. to 21st St. Turn left at 21st St. to temporary station.

WALKING FROM DUS Walk southwest on Wynkoop St. toward the 16th Street Mall. Turn right on 16th St. Follow 16th St. to Chestnut Pl. Follow Chestnut Pl. across 20th St. to 29th Ave. Turn right on 29th Ave. to Delgany St. Turn right on Delgany St. to 21st St. Turn left on 21st St. to the temporary station (approximately 30-40 minutes).

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE TEMPORARY AMTRAK STATION (1800 21st ST., DENVER 80202)

FROM THE NORTH Take I-25 south to Exit #213 (Park Ave. West). Continue to follow Park Ave. West to Wewatta St. Turn right at Wewatta St. Follow Wewatta St. to 21st.

FROM THE WEST Travel east on I-70 to I-25 South, Exit #213 (Park Ave. West). Continue to follow Park Ave. West to Wewatta St. Turn right at Wewatta St. Follow Wewatta St. to 21st St.

FROM THE EAST Travel west on I-70 to I-25 South, Exit #213 (Park Ave. West). Continue to follow Park Ave. West to Wewatta St. Turn right at Wewatta St. Follow Wewatta St. to 21st St.

FROM THE SOUTH Travel north on I-25 to Exit #212C (Park Ave. West). Continue to follow Park Ave. West to Wewatta St. Turn right at Wewatta St. Follow Wewatta St. to 21st St.

PARKING AT THE TEMPORARY AMTRAK STATION

Short-term parking spaces are available on the east side of the station for passenger drop off and pick up only. Long term parking is not available.
