

Denver Union Station construction requires long-term traffic shift on Wewatta St.

DENVER – The Denver Union Station Project Authority's contractor for the Denver Union Station redevelopment project, Kiewit Western, is continuing with construction activities including a traffic shift on Wewatta St. between 16th St. and 19th St. to provide crews access to build the underground bus facility.

Traffic will be redirected on Wewatta St. to one lane in each direction on the northbound side starting on Friday, March 5, 2010. RTD bus stops to be relocated to accommodate the changed traffic pattern. Traffic will remain in this configuration for a couple of years. There will be signage to direct traffic and bus patrons.
