DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO UNION STATION

From the North: Head south to exit 213 toward 38th Ave/Park Ave. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Park Ave. Turn left onto 38th Ave. Turn left onto 15th St. Union Station is on the right.

From the West: Head east on 6th Ave. Take the exit onto I-25 N. Take exit 212A for Speer Boulevard South. Merge onto Speer Blvd. Turn left onto 15th St. Union Station is on the right.

From the East (DIA): Head west on I-70. Follow signs for I-25 South. Keep right at the fork and follow signs for 38th Ave. Turn left onto 38th Ave. Turn left onto 15th St. Union Station is on the right.

From the South: Head north on I-25 to exit 212A for Speer Boulevard. Merge onto North Speer Blvd. Turn left onto 15th St. Union Station is on the right.
